





What is Kidzu's Community Pop-Up Museum?


With a focus on STEM education, the arts, child health and emerging literacy, Kidzu Children's Museum inspires children and the adults in their lives to learn through creative, purposeful play. Kidzu is planning a new children's museum designed to serve children and families throughout our region. We invite families to come to our FREE week-long Pop-Up Museum at Hillsborough Elementary to enjoy hands-on activities, programs and performances, and to provide insight and input on how a new children's museum can best serve kids and families throughout Orange County.

What Can We Do at the Pop-Up Museum?

The Pop-Up is a "mini-Kidzu" featuring hands-on activities focused on STEM/STEAM, the arts, child health and wellness, and emerging literacy. A mini-makerspace, storytimes and literacy activities, EdTech tools and manipulatives that engage all ages in learning will be available during specific times each day. Additionally, Kidzu has partnered with community organizations to host special programming, including: jump rope sessions with the Bouncing Bulldogs, the Instrument Zoo with NC Symphony, EdTech with SAS and CCEE, community created 3-D mural with local artists, and much more! An area of the Pop-Up Museum is devoted to sharing plans about the new museum, and a place for kids and grown-ups to tell us how a new children's museum can benefit their families and our community.

Where is Kidzu's Community Pop-Up Museum and when is it open?

The Pop-Up Museum is located in the gym at Hillsborough Elementary School. The Pop-Up Museum is open between Saturday, March 30th and Friday, April 5th at specific hours each day (preliminary schedule on reverse).
